Reconstitution

Centrifuge the vial before opening. Reconstitute to a concentration of 0.1-0.5 mg/mL in sterile distilled water. Avoid vortex or vigorously pipetting the protein. For long term storage, it is recommended to add a carrier protein or stablizer (e.g. 0.1% BSA, 5% HSA, 10% FBS or 5% Trehalose), and aliquot the reconstituted protein solution to minimize free-thaw cycles.

Description

Recombinant Human Testican-1/SPOCK1 Protein is produced by HEK293 expression system. The target protein is expressed with sequence (Arg22-Trp439) of human Testican 1/SPOCK1 (Accession #NP_004589.1.) fused with a $6 \times$ His tag at the C-terminus.

Bio-Activity

Measured by its ability to inhibit active Cathepsin L cleavage of a fluorogenic peptide substrate Z-LR-AMC. The IC50 value approximately is 1.7 nM.


Storage

Store at -20°C. Store the lyophilized protein at -20°C to -80 °C up to 1 year from the date of receipt.


After reconstitution, the protein solution is stable at -20 $^\circ C$ for 3 months, at 2-8 $^\circ C$ for up to 1 week.

Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
